ENTRIES

Pre-entries open **December 01, 2025**, and close **December 13, 2025**. **Entries must be clearly USPS postmarked no earlier than 12/01/2025**.

ALL-pre-entries must be mailed. No facsimile, telegraph, telephone, incomplete, email or computer entries will be accepted. Entries are on a first-come, first-served basis by postmark date. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEEPTED THAT REQUIRE A SIGNATURE. IF YOU OVERNIGHT MAIL, YOU MUST WAIVE SIGNATURE**.

<u>Pre-entries postmarked prior to the opening date December 01, 2025, will be returned unopened.</u>

A waiting list will be maintained if the trial is filled by postmark date of entry.

Entries must be on the official ASCA entry forms and be filled in completely (include ASCA registration number or ASCA Other Breed registration number is applicable), **ALL information must be legible**, or the entry will not be accepted. **One dog per EACH Stock Trial Entry Form will be accepted**. Entrants are responsible for errors on entry forms, please double-check everything before submitting. No entry will be accepted if it includes conditions for its acceptance. Please include a legible email address to receive updates regarding the information of your entries, this is **the only way you will be notified**. A confirmation email will be sent notifying you of the status of your entry. **AWA is not responsible for emails that are blocked by your server or end up in your spam or junk mail folders.** Non ASCA dogs can receive a tracking number from ASCA to keep track of your legs and issue your title certificates. Tracking forms are available at www.asca.org under the Quick Links, Forms and Rule books.

Additional blank entry forms can be downloaded at www.asca.org under Quick Links, Forms and Rule books. Blank entry forms are also available at the end of this printed premium.

Make Checks Payable to: Arizona Working Aussies or AWA. A check drawn on a US bank for the correct amount MUST accompany all entry forms. Postdated checks will not qualify as a valid pre-entry. Entries without proper fees will not be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and will incur a \$25 service charge and ALL legs and/or titles earned will be forfeited if the check is not made good within five (5) days of notification and will be reported to ASCA — No Exceptions. Additionally, you may be put on a "cash only" basis for future trials or events. Entry fees are non-refundable after the closing date. Refunds ONLY with vet certification of illness or injury or if someone on the waiting list is able to fill your run. DO NOT SEND CASH.

Hand delivery of entries ONLY on the day of trial. If the trial is not full, entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis during the daily registration at 7:00AM MST.

All dogs must be able to provide proof of vaccinations including rabies vaccination upon request.

STOCKDOG TRIAL POLICIES

These shows are ASCA sanctioned by Arizona Working Aussies. ALL ASCA rules apply. *Arizona Working Aussies and their members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by an exhibitor, handler, dog, property, child, or spectator*. No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, public emergencies, or other acts beyond the control of Arizona Working Aussies or the owners of the trial facility.

- + Entries must be on the official ASCA entry forms; ONE dog per entry form
- ★ An official waiting list will be maintained
- + Run order will be determined prior to the trials by random draw and posted each day of the trial
- + You are allowed to run in the trial in which you are entered ONLY. If you are not listed in the run order for a numbered trial, DO NOT RUN YOUR DOG contact the trial secretary
- + Please do not keep the judges waiting. Runs are expected to proceed as scheduled, so make sure to run during your designated slot. Delaying your run to watch others is unfair to the other handlers.
- + If the owner pulls an entry after close of pre-entries, Refunds will ONLY be made with vet certification of illness or injury or if your run is filled from the waiting list
- + ALL Cattle runs will be run in the morning before it gets too warm
- + <u>BITCHES IN SEASON WILL RUN IN DRAW ORDER but MUST be crated or kept away from the spectator area and trial arenas when not competing</u>
- + All dogs must be on a leash or crated when not competing
- + Please keep your dog quite so-as to not distract those around you or those trailing in the arenas
- Keep attendees and their dogs back from arenas when a dog is trialing
- + Potty your dog ONLY in the designated areas and PLEASE CLEAN UP after yourself AND your dogs
- + Trash cans are available throughout the property. Please be respectful of the D & D Mini-Ranch beautiful property and its community
- + Please do not confront stock workers or judges
- + If your dog is disqualified by a judge or barred from competition by the Trial Committee, there will be no refund
- + Parking in designated areas only No street parking

- + If you have a concern, see the Course Director. Your concerns will be addressed timely, and if needed presented to the Trial Committee for handling. We will take your concerns seriously and thank you for working with us to make this a great trial experience
- ★ NO SMOKING in or near the spectator area or within 50' of any structure.
- No scoresheets will be handed out prior to awards. If you will not be attending the awards you can provide a self-addressed stamped envelope, and your score sheets will be mailed to you or you may pick up the next day.
- + Spectator Area has shade cover. Designated parking has limited shade, bring your own canopies

STOCK

Cattle (3-5 Head Beef Cattle), Sheep (3-5 Head Hair Sheep), and Ducks (Khaki Campbell 5 Head).

Owners of dogs will be held responsible for all injuries to livestock during their runs. Replacement costs and/or Veterinary fees are the Handlers responsibility. Replacement costs are \$35 per duck; \$200 per sheep and market value price per cow unless otherwise posted at the time of the trial. Veterinary fees as applicable.

- + Rosette Ribbons for High Score and High Combined by division

BUCKLE AWARDS – 8 SILVER BUCKLES AWARDED for the WEEKEND

- Most Promising Started Aussie*
- Most Promising Started Other Breed*
- + High Combined NON-WTCH: *Dogs of any breed who have not yet earned/qualified for a WTCH title prior to the first day of the event
- + High Combined WTCH Aussie: Aussies that earned their WTCH before the trial begins
- + High Combined WTCH Other Breed: Other breeds that earned their WTCH before the trial begins
- + High Combined Cattle: All breeds and divisions eligible
- + High Combined Sheep: All breeds and divisions eligible
- + High Combined Ducks: All breeds and divisions eligible

A dog may compete for any high combined award as often as they like for a 90-day period after winning any high combined award at any ASCA sanctioned trial. After 90 days of winning a high combined Non-WTCH or Most Promising Started award at any ASCA sanctioned trial, the dog is ineligible to compete for or win the same buckle or overall award if competing in the same division. A dog that is ineligible to compete for a high combined award is allowed to compete indefinitely at the level for which they have qualified. This dog will be eligible for all placement awards offered in that class and division.

- *ALL Scores will be used in ALL High Combined calculations
- To be eligible for an overall combined buckle, the dog must enter all classes of stock each trial
- Owners must designate non-WTCH or WTCH buckle with entry
- Started dog must remain in the Started division, for ALL TRIALS within the EVENT, to be eligible for Most Promising Started Aussie

MPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you trom suing ASCA® and persons/entrities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement owner(s/exhibitor(s)handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®): its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks neglect compliance with health and safety there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property, as well as any heir, beneficiarry, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (4) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have anisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant's dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant's promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforocable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from—among other things—claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant.
